- University of the South Pacific (USP)

(networking, info & skill sharing)
- Pacific Invasives Initiative (PII)  
(technical support for projects)



## Role of PIP

- Promote coordination, reduce competition and duplication.
- Identify gaps, promote strategic planning and fund-raising.
- Monitor for progress/failures and develop lessons learnt.

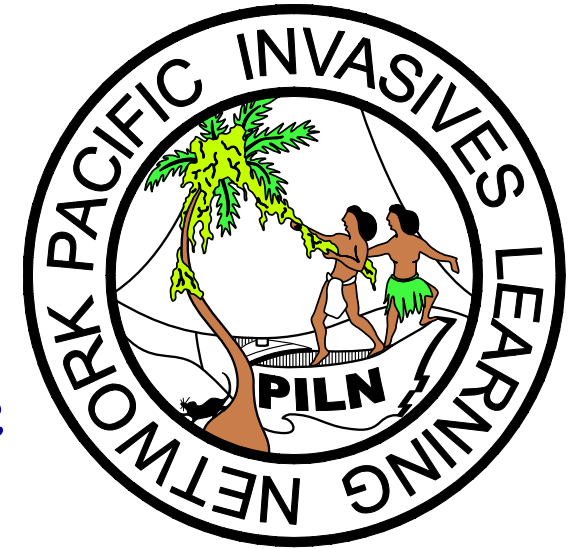

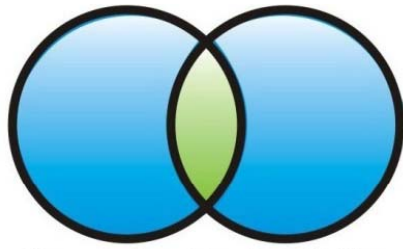
# PILN
